Using Video to Share People's Comments

This handout will teach you how to upload a video filmed on a smart phone to Google drive and share basic steps we used to create a video for an advocacy event/campaign.

Background:

- If your group has someone good at editing videos you can create a 10-minute video by asking members of your organization to film comments for an advocacy campaign. Collect 20 or more video clips of people speaking up.
- For example, during August 2016 we asked self-advocates to come up with a brief statement (less than 1-minute long) for Direct Support Professional week. People were asked to film comments about why a support person in their life is important. We emphasized that Instead of just describing what they do, we wanted everyone to focus on explaining why it is important!



- People filmed their own videos using a smart phone. The folks who did not have a smart phone we able to be filmed during a meeting of their local selfadvocacy group by asking a friend/ally to film them.
- Before sending us their video clip we asked everyone to look at their video and to film it again if they think they can do better.
- During August 2016, people with disabilities from 12 different local selfadvocacy groups filmed short video clips. They used the following directions to send GMSA their videos by uploading them to Google drive.

Using Google Drive

Google Drive is a safe and free place to store your files. We like to use it because you can easily share large files like video files with others. For our video project people used Google Drive which is a free app to download. If you have a Gmail account, you most likely have access to Google Drive

iPhones

You can upload a video to Google Drive from an iPhone. People with iPhones used directions on how to upload to Google drive found at https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0AsNg XZ8K8






If using an android smart phone, follow the instructions below to send your video to someone by uploading it to Google Drive.


- 1. Shoot your video

3. Save to your Google Drive




4. Name it anything you want and then touch Save




5. Go to your Google Drive App




6. Select the video you just saved.
