Your attorney will need

- Your Supported Decision Making plan
- Your probate court file
- An affidavit from your doctor
- A list of possible witnesses and their contact information (family members, caregivers, employers, neighbors, etc)
- Important documents (budget, documentation about employment, pay stubs, etc)
