- Advisors do not vote in the decisions made by the group
- Advisors do not make decisions for the group

WHAT MAKES A GOOD ADVISOR?

- Helps run the meetings, but won't take over
- Needs to show up, be responsible, and on time
- Explains what you do not understand
- **Helps** with the agenda
- Might assist people to schedule their rides to meetings and events
- Is committed to the group
- Is understanding and patient
- Supports members when they want to talk about a sensitive issue
- Is trustworthy
