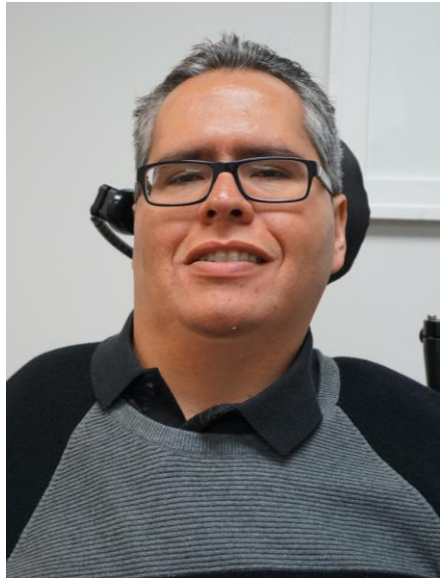

- Members will review items and provide advice. These items will help improve self advocacy among individuals and organizations.

Advisory committee member role includes the following:

- 1) Set priorities for materials and topics featured on SARTAC website and on webinars
- 2) Participate in the selection of Fellows through reviews of applicants and/or final approval of selections
- 3) Provide input into the selection of agencies and groups for the project's technical assistance
- 4) Use feedback from state and local groups to pick topics for translation
- 5) Provide input and approve the logic model for evaluation
- 6) Work on a sustainability plan for the project
- 7) Provide oversight and feedback of partners' work on projects

- Must be able to work with a diverse group of people in both culture and disabilities
